#### Market Prediction

Yesterday, JCI closed +0.47% higher to 7,466.83. Foreigners recorded net buy of 599.53B (all market) and net buy of 352.90B (RG market). The top 5 foreign net buy stocks were BBCA (256.2B), BMRI (140.3B), ASII (74.1B), BREN (51.9B), & BBNI (39.9B). Meanwhile, the top 5 net sellers are BBRI (166.6B), TLKM (63.2B), TPIA (62.7B), ANTM (56.2B), UNVR (25.3B).

Wall Street's major indices closed higher (DJI +0.58%, GSPC +0.97%, IXIC +1.39%). EIDO closed up +0.94%. Optimism among investors is high as they anticipate a potential rate cut from the Federal Reserve, with a keynote speech by Fed Chair Jerome Powell at the upcoming Jackson Hole symposium being in focus.

Today's index is expected to move sideways with the opportunity to strengthen again.

JCI price closed all time high. Indicator from stochastic is golden cross, MACD histogram is moving positive (line is bullish) and volume is decreasing. Bearish scenario: If it moves bearish again, JCI is expected to weaken again to the support range of 7,409 – 7,420. Bullish scenario: If JCI is able to move bullish, JCI has the opportunity to break resistance 7,511 – 7,522.

### Commodities:

- WTI crude oil futures fell more than 2.5% below \$75 per barrel on Monday, continuing a 1.9% decline from the previous session amid ongoing cease-fire talks in Gaza and concerns about weakening demand, particularly from China. US Secretary of State Antony Blinken is in Israel, emphasizing the urgency of reaching a cease-fire and releasing hostages, with further negotiations planned in Cairo this week.
- Gold traded around \$2,500 per ounce on Monday, hovering at an all-time high, driven by strong demand for safe-haven assets while markets evaluated the Federal Reserve's policy outlook. Reports indicated that US Secretary of State Antony Blinken is in the Middle East to broker ceasefire negotiations with Gaza.
  - Malaysian palm oil futures traded slightly higher amid soybean oil's gains Friday in the CBoT market. Prices hovered near MYR 3,690 per tonne following a slump of almost 2% in the prior session, helped by reports of low inventories at the end of July, with Malaysia's palm oil stocks staying at 1.73 million metric tons. the lowest since March.

Macro Economic News

- Residential property prices in Indonesia climbed by 1.76% year-on-year during the second quarter of 2024, slowing from a 1.89% rise in the previous period as prices moderated across all categories: small houses (2.09% vs 2.41% in Q1), medium ones (1.45% vs 1.60%), and large properties (1.47% vs 1.53%).
- Japan's core machinery orders, which exclude those for ships and electric power companies, rose by 2.1% month-over-month to JPY 876.1 billion in June 2024, exceeding market estimates of 1.1% and shifting from a 3.2% fall in May.
- The Federal Reserve maintained the federal funds rate at a 23-year high of 5.25%-5.50% for the 8th consecutive meeting in July 2024, in line with expectations. Policymakers noted that there has been some further progress toward the 2% inflation goal although it remains somewhat elevated.

### **Corporate news**

- **PT Arkora Hydro Tbk. (ARKO)** and its subsidiary, PT Arkora Hydro Malili, have secured a Rp223 billion loan facility from PT Sarana Multi Infrastruktur. The facility will be used for the construction of a hydroelectric power plant project in South Sulawesi.
- PT Century Textile Industry Tbk. (CNTX) plans to change the status of the company from open to closed or go private. Related to that CNTX will make a tender offer at a price of Rp 400 per share.
- Coal issuer PT Indo Tambangraya Megah Tbk. (ITMG) plans to optimize cost efficiency and tool
  management to support increased production volume in the second half of 2024, as they are
  confident about high coal demand from China, India, and Southeast Asia. In the first half of 2020,
  ITMG's coal production increased by 14% and sales volume increased by 9% compared to the
  same period last year, but revenue decreased by 19.22%.
- **PT Puri Sentul Permai Tbk. (KDTN)** and PT Jasa Marga Related Business will build an xpress hotel at the Km 379A rest area. The hotel will have a swimming pool, children's play area and will cooperate with banks and MSMEs.
- PT. MNC Digital Entertainment Tbk. (MSIN) plans to split its shares at a ratio of 1:5 in order to increase trading liquidity and make the shares more affordable for investors. The share split will be proposed for shareholder approval at an Extraordinary General Meeting to be held on 23 September 2024.
- **PT Prima Globalindo Logistik Tbk. (PPGL),** a logistics and delivery company, recorded a net profit of Rp8,34 billion in the first half (1H) 2024. This profit decreased by 12.4% year-on-year (yoy) compared to the same semester last year, where the company posted a profit of Rp9.52 billion.

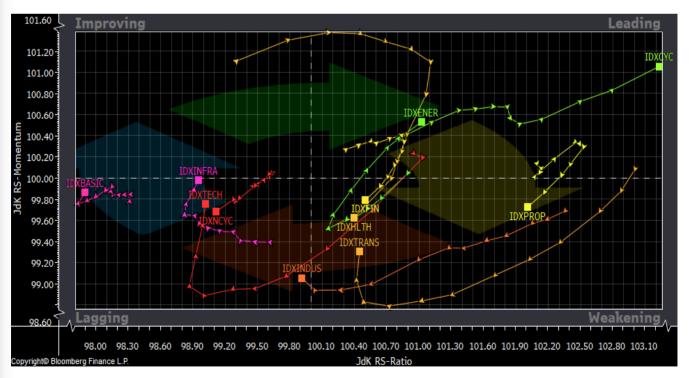
