#### Market Prediction

Yesterday, JCI closed down -0.26% to 7,543.83. Foreigners recorded net sell of 1.10 trillion (all market) and net sell of 916.50 billion (RG market). The top 5 foreign net buy stocks were ASII (127.7B), BRPT (87.3B), SMGR (49.1B), ANTM (37.9B), & FILM (14.2B). Meanwhile, the top 5 net sellers are BBRI (728.5B), BBCA (117.7B), TLKM (78.9B), GOTO (70.5B), MAPI (59.2B).

Major Wall Street indices closed lower (DJI -0.44%, GSPC -0.17%, IXIC -0.04%). EIDO closed down -1.12%. Wall Street sentiment soured after President Biden signaled support for Israel attacking Iranian oil facilities, raising concerns about disruptions to global energy supplies. Oil prices surged more than 5%, driven by concerns related to the conflict, pushing energy stocks higher. Meanwhile, US services sector data showed expansion in September, which briefly lifted markets before retreating. The labor market showed signs of cooling, with a slight increase in jobless claims and lower planned layoffs.

Today's index is expected to move volatile again with a tendency to weaken.

JCI closed negative with bearish candle. Indicator from stochastic is golden cross, MACD histogram is moving bearish (line is sloping) and volume is decreasing. Bearish scenario: If it moves bearish again, JCI is expected to weaken again to the support range 7,488 – 7,504. Bullish scenario: If JCI is able to move bullish, JCI has the opportunity strengthen to the resistance range 7,581 – 7,597.

#### **Commodities:**

- WTI crude oil futures surged 5% to \$73.7 per barrel on Thursday, extending the week's surge to a one-month high after US President Biden refrained from outright condemning the possibility that Israel may attack Iran's oil facilities. Besides the consequent shock to shortterm supplies that such an attack would bring.
- Gold held around \$2,655 per ounce on Thursday, remaining relatively close to record highs as the deepening Middle East crisis continued to enhance the metal's safe-haven appeal.
- Malaysian palm oil futures slipped more than 1% to below MYR 4,150 per tonne, amid profit-taking after the contracts surged 4.7% in the previous session, their largest daily gain in 15 months, following strength in crude oil prices and Chicago soyoil.

Macro Economic News

- The au Jibun Bank Japan Services PMI for September 2024 was revised lower to 53.1, the lowest in three months, compared with the flash figure of 53.9. Still, the latest result indicated the third straight month of growth in the service sector, following August's print of 53.7.
- The S&P Global UK Services PMI fell to 52.4 in September 2024, down from 53.7 in August and revised lower from an initial estimate of 52.8. Although the growth pace moderated, overall business activity stayed robust, driven by rising domestic demand, especially in sectors like technology, real estate, and leisure services.
- The ISM Services PMI in the US soared to 54.9 in September 2024 from 51.5 in August and much higher than forecasts of 51.7. The reading pointed to the strongest growth in the services sector since February 2023 amid faster increases in business activity (59.9 vs 53.3).

## **Corporate news**

- **PT. Astra International Tbk. (ASII)** will distribute interim dividends for the 2024 financial year period. The cum and ex-dividend periods for the regular and negotiated markets will be conducted on October 11 and October 14, 2024, while the cum and ex-dividend periods for the cash market will be conducted on October 15 and October 16, 2024.
- On 1 October 2024, Bintarna Tardy, President Commissioner of PT. Toba Surimi Industries Tbk. (CRAB), increased his share ownership by purchasing 19,000,000 shares at Rp218 per share for investment purposes. His shareholding in CRAB is now 378.5 million shares, representing 19.41% of the total issued share capital.
- **PT. Garuda Indonesia Tbk. (GIAA)** recorded a net loss inflation throughout semester I/2024. Swelling loss due to a surge in load, especially fuel as well as maintenance and repair.
- PT. Menthobi Hijau Lestari (MHL), a subsidiary of PT. Menthobi Karyatama Raya Tbk. (MKTR), has entered into a cooperative agreement with PT. Berlian Inti Mekar (BIM) for the management of a compost fertilizer plant.
- **PT. Samuel Tumbuh Bersama, a shareholder of PT. Nusantara Sawit Sejahtera Tbk. (NSSS)**, sold 11,914,700 shares of NSSS at Rp179 per share, resulting in a reduction of their share ownership to 26.95%.
- **PT. PP Tbk. (PTPP)** has completed the East Java Multipurpose Terminal Port project in Lamongan, East Java, with a contract value of Rp767 billion.


