Market Overview

TRUMP CALLS OFF IRAN STRIKES, WALL STREET POSTS BIGGEST RALLY IN 2 MONTHS, SPACEX DELIVERS RECORD-BREAKING IPO

U.S. MARKET: Wall Street surged sharply in Thursday's trading (June 11, 2026) after President Donald Trump canceled plans for an attack on Iran and stated that a peace pact could potentially be signed within the next few days. Dow Jones rose 1.86% to 50,848.75, S&P 500 strengthened 1.75% to 7,394.30, while Nasdaq jumped 2.54% to 25,809.66. All three indices recorded their largest daily gains since April 08. The technology sector led the strengthening. Philadelphia Semiconductor Index (SOX) surged 7.9%, its largest daily increase since April 2025. Micron rose 12%, Intel rose 9%, while Oracle plummeted 8.5% after announcing FY2027 capital expenditure plans of USD 95 billion, well above market expectations. Nvidia reported that sovereign AI revenue grew more than 80% YoY in the first quarter of FY2027, while Broadcom maintained its AI revenue target of more than USD 100 billion in FY2027.

- **SpaceX set its IPO price at USD 135 per share** and successfully raised USD 75 billion, making it the largest IPO in history with a valuation reaching USD 1.77 trillion. The stock will begin trading on Nasdaq on Friday.

MARKET SENTIMENT: Trump stated that the discussion and final points of the peace pact with Iran have been approved by all related parties and the signing can take place in the near future.

Trump also said the Strait of Hormuz will reopen once the pact is signed, while the US naval blockade against Iran will be lifted. Nonetheless, tensions have not completely subsided. The US and Iran still traded strikes through Thursday, while the market remains watchful of global energy supply disruption risks from the Strait of Hormuz.

FIXED INCOME & CURRENCY: The Dollar Index fell 0.3% to 99.69 in line with diminishing safe-haven demand. The Euro strengthened 0.4% to USD 1.1578 after the ECB raised interest rates by 25bps to 2.25%.

- **US Treasury yields fell by around 8-9 bps across almost all tenors.** May US producer inflation (PPI) data showed the PPI rose 1.1% MoM and 6.5% YoY, higher than expectations. Meanwhile, the Core PPI rose 0.4% MoM and 4.9% YoY, lower than estimated.
- **The market now expects at least one Fed interest rate hike before the end of the year,** with focus fixed on Kevin Warsh's first meeting as Fed Chairman on June 17.

EUROPE & ASIA MARKET: European markets strengthened after the ECB raised interest rates by 25bps to 2.25%, the first increase in nearly 3 years. STOXX 600 rose 0.6%, FTSE 100 strengthened 0.5%, DAX rose 0.1%, and Italy's FTSE MIB gained 1%. The ECB revised its inflation projection to 3.0% this year, 2.3% in 2027, and 2.0% in 2028. Meanwhile, the Eurozone economic growth projection was pared to 0.8%. Goldman Sachs raised the target prices for ASML, ASMI, BESI, and Nebius after seeing increasingly robust AI and semiconductor demand outlooks.

- **In Asia,** KOSPI rose 0.2% and Nikkei strengthened 0.1% after pressure on the technology sector began to ease. Conversely, Hang Seng fell 1.3% due to the weakening of Alibaba and JD.com. Japan announced that around 100% of July crude oil imports will come from sources outside the Strait of Hormuz, compared to previously when more than 90% of supply relied on that route. Japan will also increase oil imports from the US by more than 10-fold compared to last year.

MACRO ECONOMIC NEWS

- Indonesia's retail sales fell 3.7% YoY in April 2026, reversing a 3.4% increase in the prior month and marking the first decline since April 2025.
- South Korea's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate stood at 2.8% in May 2026, unchanged from April. The economy lost 40,000 jobs during the month, the first decline in employment in 17 months, amid economic uncertainty, bringing total employment to 29.120 million.
- The European Central Bank raised interest rates by 25 basis points at its June 2026 meeting, the first increase since 2023, as policymakers emphasized their commitment to anchoring inflation at the 2% medium-term target.
- Producer prices for final demand in the US increased 1.1% mom in May 2026, the same as a downwardly revised 1.1% rise in April, and once again above forecasts of 0.7%. Prices of goods soared 2.8%, following a 1.9% jump in April, with over half of advance attributable to a 23.4% increase in gasoline.

COMMODITY: Oil prices plunged after Trump canceled plans for an attack on Iran. Brent fell 4.5% to USD 88.91 / barrel, while US WTI dropped 4.2% to USD 86.26 / barrel. Despite falling sharply, oil prices remain well waves above levels before the conflict began. EIA data showed US crude oil inventories fell 7.2 million barrels last week, well waves above the expected 3 million barrel draw.

- Spot gold prices rose 2.4% to USD 4,169,42 / oz**, while gold futures rose 1.4% to USD 4,189.72 / oz in line with a weakening US Dollar and rising safe-haven demand.

INDONESIA: Foreign investors still recorded a net sell of Rp 261 billion in yesterday's trading, bringing the cumulative net sell so far this year to around Rp78.5 trillion. The outflow of foreign funds indicates that global investors still tend to be cautious about Indonesian assets amid high domestic and global uncertainties, including the weakening Rupiah, issues of Indonesia risk perception, and the continuing "Sell Indonesia" trend that has taken place over the past few months. In the short term, global investors' attention is also being drawn to several massive events, such as the USD 75 billion SpaceX IPO which is the largest IPO in history, and the commencement of the FIFA World Cup in the United States, which has the potential to divert some focus and global market liquidity to high-profile assets; as well as to sports betting tables. Historically, the stock market tends to slow down when this major sporting event is underway. On the domestic side, the market is also monitoring plans for student demonstrations in Jakarta today, which risk adding to foreign investors' concerns regarding Indonesia's social and political stability. As long as these factors still overshadow, foreign capital flows are expected to be selective and have not fully returned to the Indonesian stock market.

JCI underwent a quite volatile session yesterday on Thursday, briefly rising to 6,000 before dropping to an intraday Low of 5,784.5 and finally closing the trade down by only 16.34pts / -0.28% to the 5,886 level. Foreign Net Sell was recorded at IDR 261 billion (cumulative YTD: IDR 78.5T), dominated by stocks like BBRI, DSSA, and ASII (transaction value > 100 billion), though BBCA was snapped up by foreigners amounting to IDR 388 billion. **KIWOOM RESEARCH** needs to remind investors/traders to refrain from taking more buy positions for now, to anticipate social unrest shocks / other global-domestic factors during the weekend.

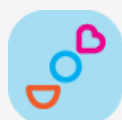

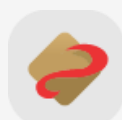

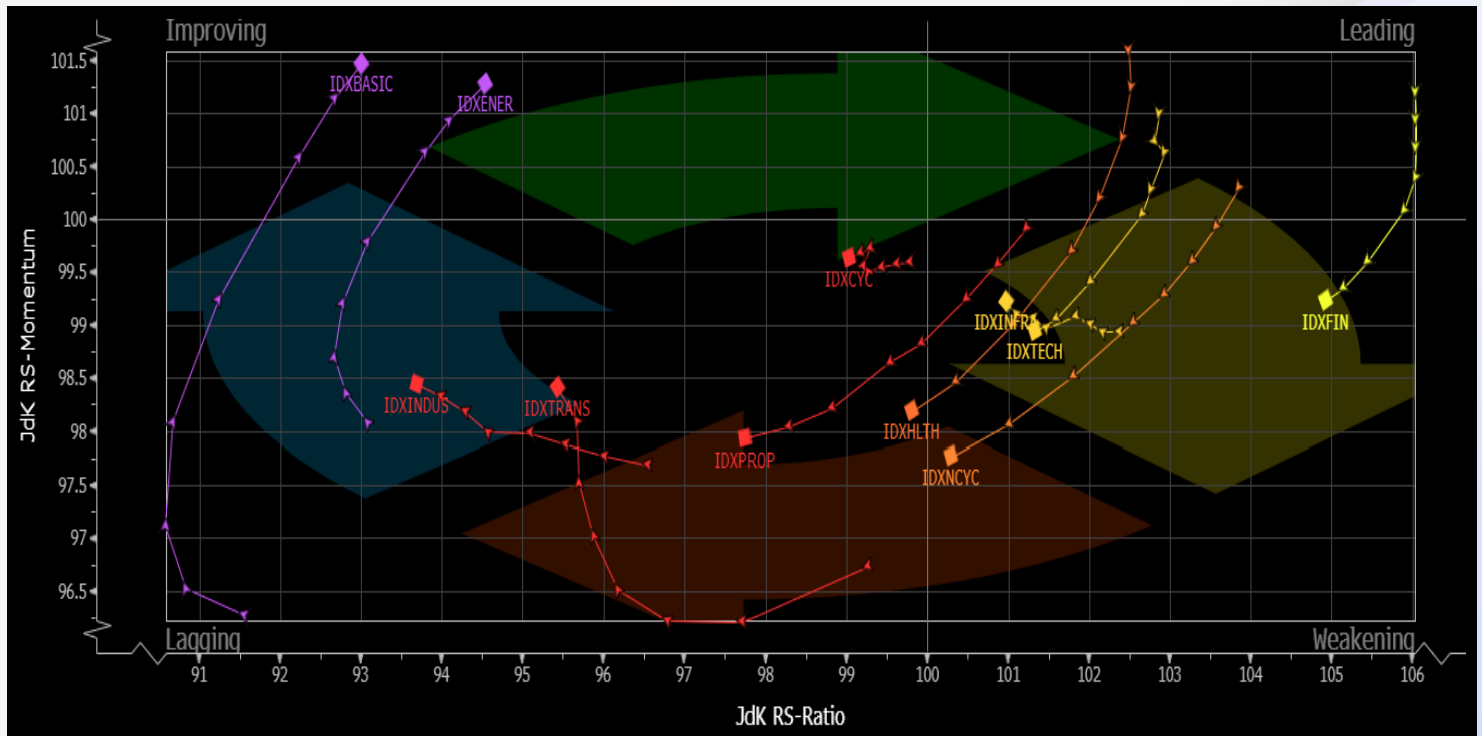
